# 1. Background and objective of teaching quality assessment (1/2)

#### **Background**

- Before 2015, the University use **Teaching effectiveness** survey (paper base) for teaching quality assessment
- New teaching quality assessment is effective on 2015





# 1. Background and objective of teaching quality assessment (2/2)

## **Objective**

- To let students provide feedback to the University on the effectiveness of their course learning experience
- Students are encouraged to suggest ways to improve the class
- Enhance the quality of the course and teaching performance
- Document the quality of the course and teaching performance






## 2. Current teaching quality assessment method

• Mid-term survey

Student feedback questionnaires



## 3. Mid-term survey

- Survey is teacher oriented
- Teachers adjust the survey questions according to their own needs
- Teachers can utilize their teaching ways according to results
- The survey will be carried out at the end of the first month of class
- Comments are collected by paper or electronic base survey





# 4. Student feedback questionnaires (SFQ) (1/8)

- Online SFQ system is effective since 2015
- SFQ will be carried out once per semester, it is conducted within the last three weeks before the last day of classes
- Students fill the questionnaires in an anonymous manner

#### **Achievement**

- Increase data accuracy
- Enhance information security and privacy
- Reduce survey processing time





## 4. Student feedback questionnaires (SFQ) (2/8)

#### 4.1 Process of SFQ

#### 1. Preparation

Ensure course and instructor data in the system

Confirm survey type for each courses

Generate survey for each classes

#### 2. Finish survey

Invite students to fill the survey for their taken course

Students login to SFQ system and finish the survey

#### 3. Generate report

Analysis data and generate SFQ report

Inform faculties and departments to download the reports

Faculties members check the reports

Distribute individual report to each teaching staff



## 4. Student feedback questionnaires (SFQ) (3/8)

### 4.2 Types of SFQ survey and composition

Categorize by course nature, there 8 types of survey:

**Lecture Courses** 

Laboratory Courses/ Sessions

Language & Skills Courses

General Education Courses

Project-Based Courses

**Teaching Practice Courses** 

**IT Courses** 

**Online Courses** 

Each survey is comprised by:


"About the course" and "About the instructor"

4.5 SFQ response rate by units (AY2018 & AY 2019)



# 4. Student feedback questionnaires(SFQ) (8/8)

### 4.6 Promotion of SFQ

- Vice rector (Academic Affairs) shares SFQ information in UM Town Hall meetings and Dean's meetings
- Inform teaching staff and student about the SFQ news by SMS and email
- Students who have completed all SFQ will automatically be entered into the
  - lucky draw
- Post poster in the campus
- Publish SFQ newsletter on e-bulletin





#### 5. Use of SFQ outcomes

- As a **factor in considering** the progression, promotion and renewal decisions for <u>regular</u> teaching staff
- As a **factor in considering** the 'contract renewal' for <u>non-regular</u> and <u>service</u> contract teaching staff
- Deans of faculty/ directors of institute review SFQ reports carefully, and discuss
   the potential improvement actions with the concerned instructor
- VRAA office send the letter of concern to low performance teaching staff
- <u>VRAA/AAO/CTLE</u> will analyze the data and produce the overall reports. The reports should then be sent to the Academic Quality Assurance Committee for review and recommendations.



### 6. Challenge of teaching quality assessment

- To enhance SFQ promotion, and keep/increase students' response rate
- To review and adjust content of the survey, in order to ensure the outcomes reflect the actual teaching effectiveness
- To ensure system performs excellent, and provide valid evaluation to faculties and teaching staff
- Monitor units' communication, to ensure teaching staffs improve their teaching quality according to evaluation outcome
- University keeps monitoring the data. It is used a blue print of teaching staff's assessment in the area of teaching and course planning
