Designing for inquiry-based learning with the Learning Activity Management System

GROUPS ARE ESSENTIAL FOR PEER INTERACTION



Build online groups of 5-10 students for meaningful interactions or documenting progress

- a) Randomly form groups
- b) Self-selecting groups
- c) Purposeful

Then, students can submit a group assignment or participate in a group discussion forum

3 TOOLS FOR FORMING ONLINE GROUPS IN MOODLE

<u>Manually</u> set up random groups and create a grouping (a set of groups).

*Groupings help when setting up activities and when you have more than one set of groups.

For <u>self-selecting</u> groups, 1st create groups (and a grouping) and let students choose using the Group Choice activity.

<u>Automate</u> the process with <u>TeamBuilder</u> (works with large classes)

GROUP ASSIGNMENT



Use a standard "Assignment"

- one member of the group submits a file
- members of the group can download, update and re-upload a file or edit a text entry
