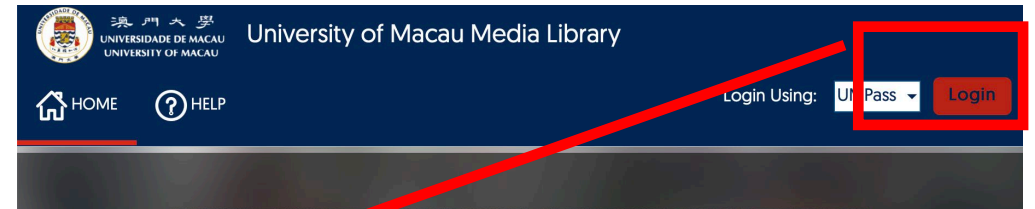

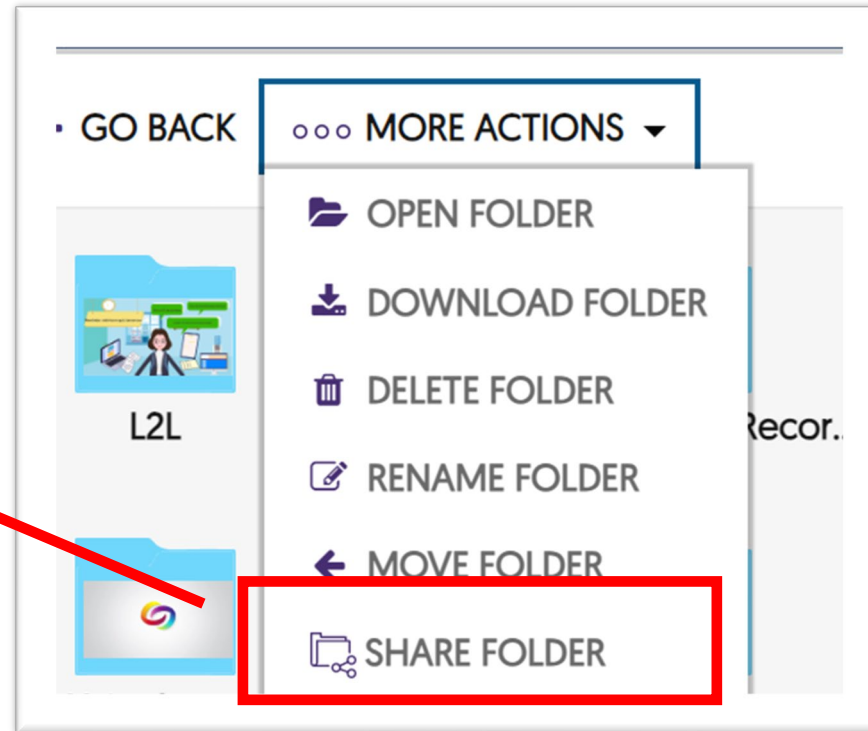
Default Collection

YuJa prepares the videos for playback on any device

To share a folder with one or two TAs, for editing, etc.



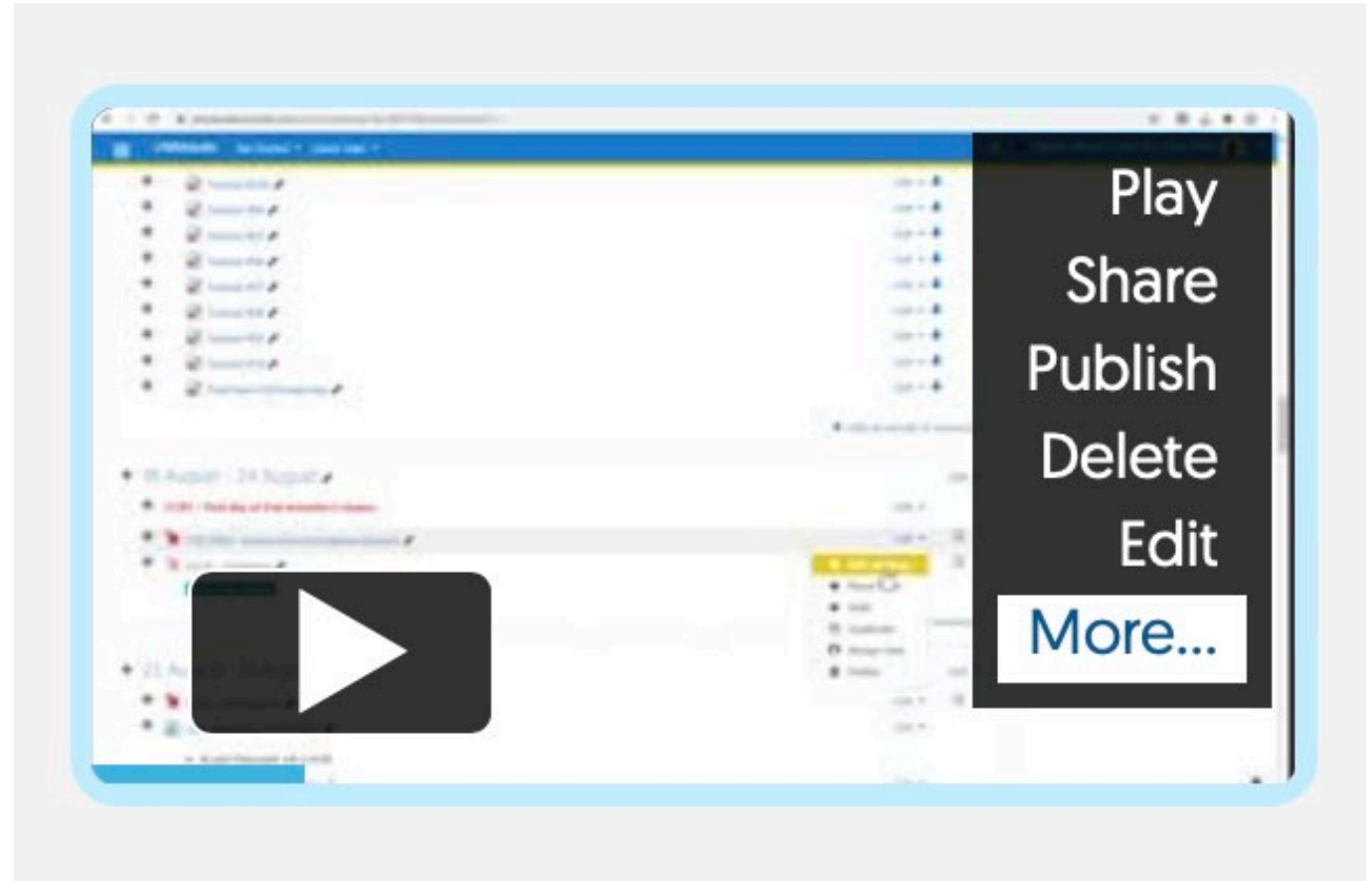

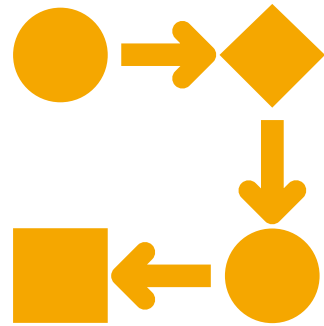

Safari browser settings can block data from being passed from Moodle to YuJa. Uncheck "Prevent cross-site tracking"

Chrome or Firefox browsers should be more compatible by default.

Essential to know

Enabling Third-Party Cookies [link1](#) / 在 Mac 的 Safari 中防止跨網站追蹤 [link2](#)

Videos you upload to YuJa are saved to the "My Media" folder by default

Instructors may create a one-stop "YuJa channel" for each course (similar to a YouTube channel)

Then, teachers/TA may choose to "publish" videos to a channel
